School-Based Programme for Post-Primary Students



Complex Needs/Inclusion Programme (2 weeks)

- For students with complex needs and the remainder to be allocated to students at greatest risk of educational disadvantage
- Pupil groups of up to 12 students supported by one teacher and SNA support

Transport

School transport services may be available to students who avail of services under the SEN transport scheme. Where services are not available for students who normally avail of SEN transport scheme, grant funding is payable to parents following completion of the programme.

Home-Based Summer Provision for Post-Primary Children with Complex Needs



If your child's school is not providing a school-based programme, 40 hours home support is available through the home-based summer programme for students with complex needs.

The following categories of students are considered as students with complex needs for the school-based programme:

- All students enrolled in special schools and special classes
- Students in mainstream classes in post-primary schools who are accessing the highest level of the continuum of support (Student Support Plus/for a few). This includes students with autism, Down syndrome, sensory impairments, and other disabilities who were identified for the supplementary programme earlier this year
