




SATURDAY SUPERVISED STUDY FOR 6TH YEARS



- Thanks also to all the parents and local businesses who donated raffle prizes.










MARCH 2025: CYBERSAFETY FOR TEENS

- Congratulations to Fiona Newman Casey who made a wonderful balloon feature for all the photos.






MAY 2025: PRE-LOVED UNIFORMS PROGRAMME
