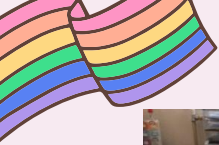

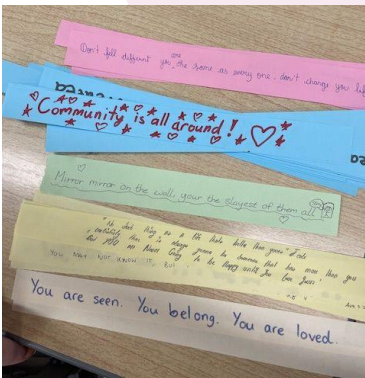
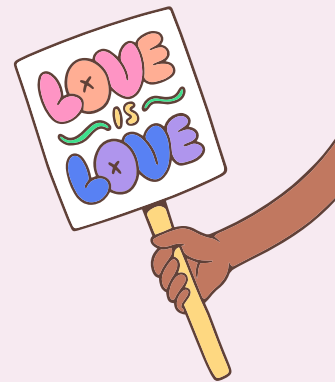

Launch of the Student Leaders Board

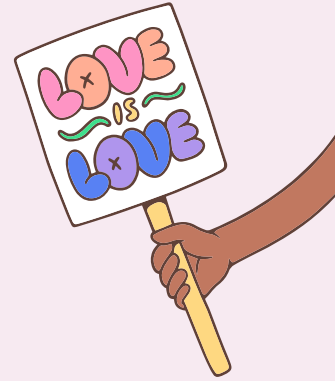

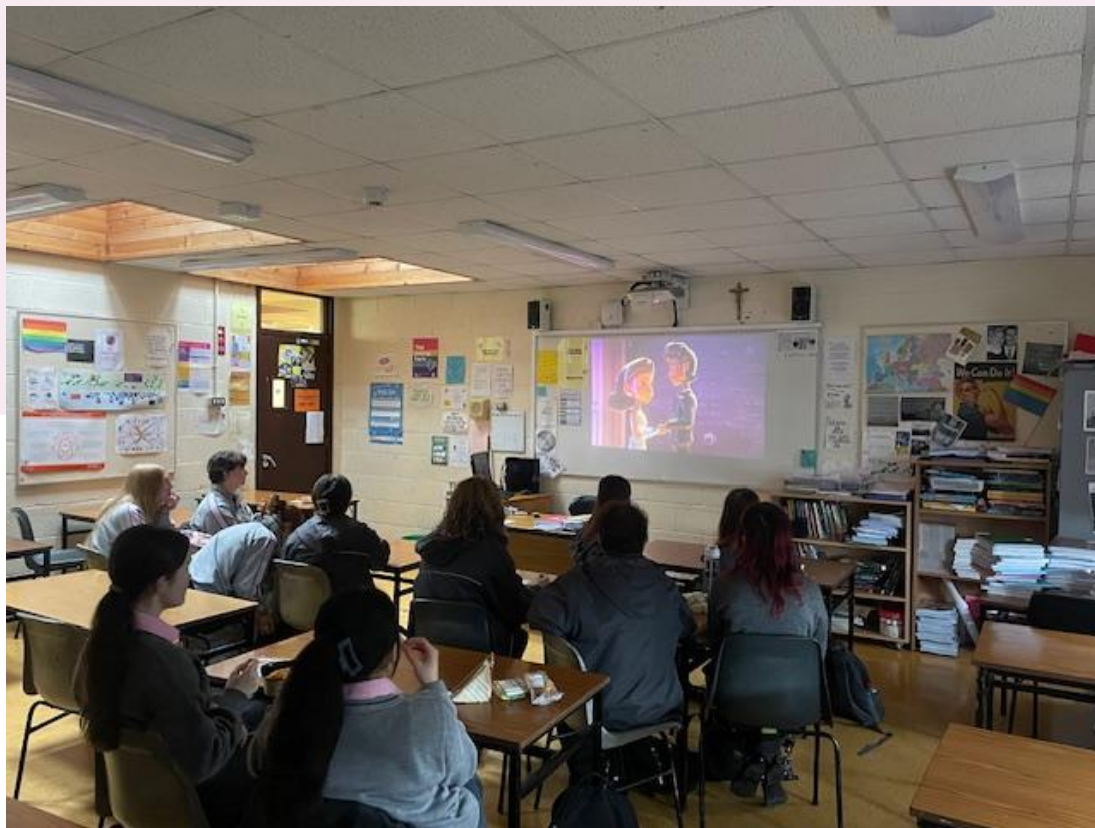

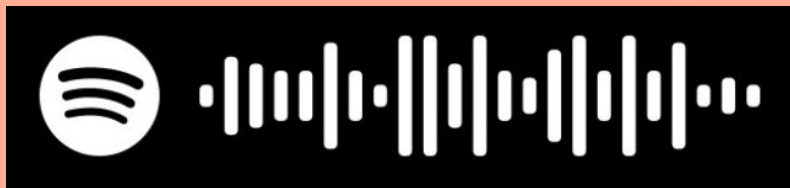
