

Important Notice Regarding Student Parking and Use of E-Scooters

Dear Parents and Guardians,

The Board of Management of St. Clement's College recently discussed a number of matters relating to student safety and compliance with current legislation. Following these discussions, the Board has directed that the following information be communicated to all school stakeholders.

Students who drive to school are **not permitted to park anywhere on the school campus**. This includes all school grounds and car parking areas.

In addition, arising from recent legislation, **students under the age of 16 are not permitted to use e-scooters**. Consequently, students are also **not permitted to bring, use, or store e-scooters on the school campus** under any circumstances.

Parents and guardians are advised to familiarise themselves with the relevant guidance issued by the **Road Safety Authority** (www.rsa.ie) regarding the lawful and safe use of e-scooters.

We ask for your cooperation and support in ensuring that all students comply with these directions, which are in place to promote the safety and wellbeing of our school community and to ensure adherence to legal requirements.
